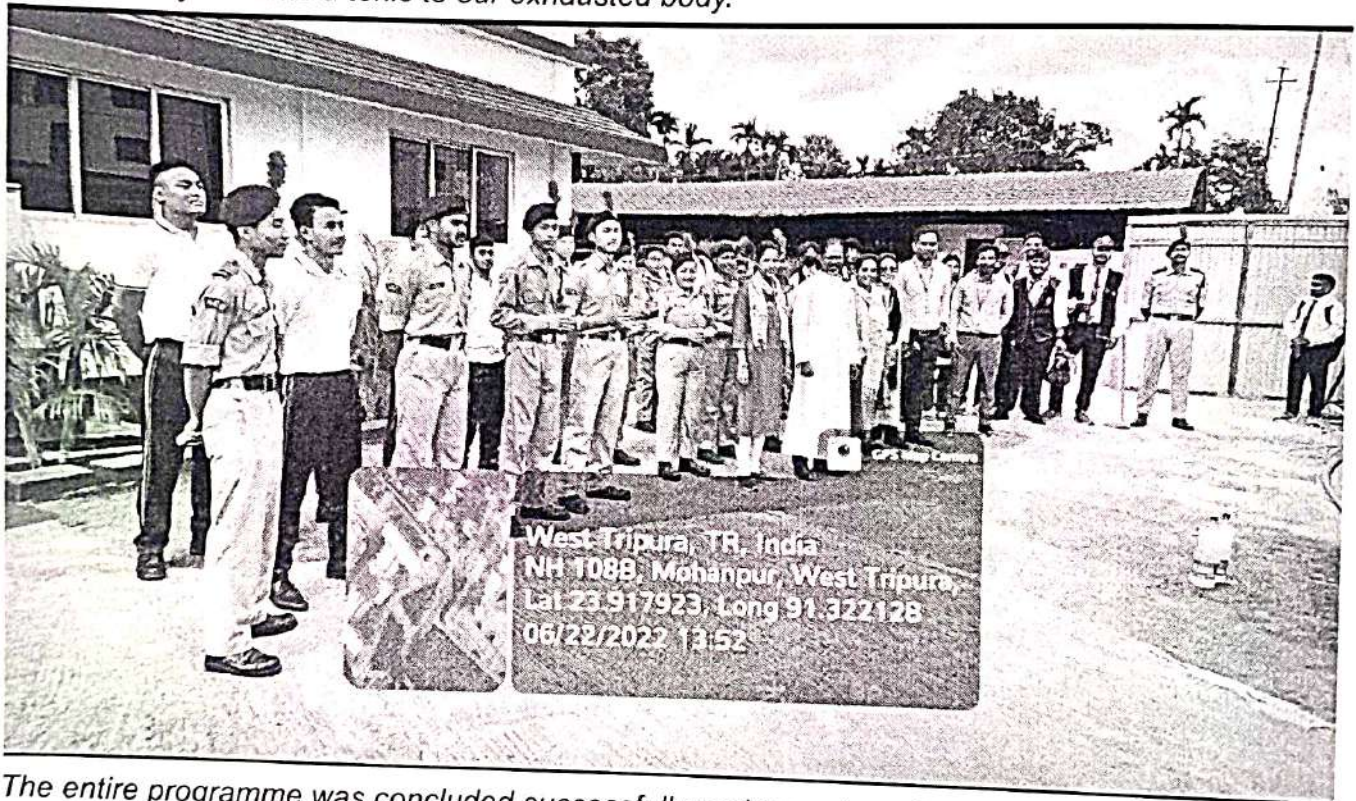


## PLANTATION CUM SAPLING DISTRIBUTION PROGRAMME.

### **Departmental visit to an Old Age Home on 7th July 2022**
