BLESSED BASIL MOREAU (1799-1873)

Basil Moreau the founder of the community of Holy Cross was born in Laigne-en-Belin, a town in Le Mans, France on February 11, 1799. As a priest of the diocese of Le Mans and seminary professor, he established the Association of Holy Cross consisting of two societies one of men (brothers and priests) and the other of women, both having as principal ministries, the education of youth. He was raised to the status of Blessed by the Church on September 15, 2007 for living heroic virtues in life. Through the leadership of Blessed Basil Moreau Holy Cross Contributed mightily for the building up of France that was devastated by the Revolution.

The men and women of Holy Cross maintain educational institutions as well as important social and pastoral ministries in North and South America, Africa and Asia. Holy Cross has a strong presence in Northeast India since 1853, the then undivided India. Holy Cross Universities, Colleges and Schools across the world are considered as excellent institutions of learning. Blessed Basil Moreau was an educator with very definite ideas about teaching and learning and about curriculum in terms of both content and methodology. Courses Offered:

B.Sc (HUMAN PHYSIOLOGY)

"The physiology of today is the medicine of tomorrow" - Emst H. Starting. Physiologist (1926).

The Department of Human Physiology started in 2012 as an Elective course and afterward received permission from Tripura University to offer it as an Honours course in 2016. Human Physiology is the science of the functioning of human organs and the cells that compose them. As a discipline, it connects science, medicine, and health and investigates the interaction and coordination of molecules, cells, tissues, and organs and how these parts make up the whole body.

At the undergraduate level, students can develop academic competence at the highest level attainable and be introduced to the forefront of current knowledge in human physiology. The practical modules cover hematology, experimental, biochemical, nutritional, molecular biology, microbiology, etc. The lecture modules include neuroscience, regulatory physiology, neuromuscular physiology, perspectives in physiology research, cell signaling, etc. Apart from core physiology, other units are also involved, like biochemistry, microbiology, molecular biology, genetics, immunology, ergonomics, nutrition, statistics, and many more. Initially, the Department of Human Physiology (Honours) was established with a capacity of twenty (20) students. Presently, the intake capacity has increased to sixty (60) seats.

We also offer a Certificate Course on Laboratory Techniques from December 2021 onwards to develop job-oriented skills. Our students actively participate in various social outreach programs and internships/ training. field study and study trips, etc. As a whole, the dept. is focusing on providing quality education and sound personality development for our students to make them competent enough for leadership. Our future plans are to start a PG course in Human Physiology and also to establish a dedicated Molecular Biology and Cell Culture Laboratory.

B.Sc (ZOOLOGY)

Zoology is a comprehensive study of animals, their diversity and biological processes, the link between animals and their environment and different zoological phenomenon from molecular to ecological levels. It also focusses on the structure, function, behavior and evolution of animals. Thrust area of the department includes Taxonomy and Animal Classification, Cell Biology, Histology, Genetics, Microbiology, Parasitology, Biostatistics, Endocrinology, Biochemistry, Molecular Biology, Animal Physiology, Immunology, Developmental Biology, Genetic Engineering and Environmental Biology. Amongst many things, students here get to know about the origin and evolution of species, their habitats and interaction with the living and nonliving environment, heredity and genetic variation in animals. Embryological details in the subject enables one to understand the growth and development of organism and immunological studies gives an understanding of body’s defense mechanism against pathogens. Department of Zoology, Holy Cross College, thus helps students in proper understanding of the animal world and its diversity. It goes beyond the prescribed syllabus to arouse interests amongst students about the animal world and aims in making the learners become scientifically aware of the environment such that sustainable development is ensured for the progress of future generation. Best practices of the department include collection of specimens by the students to add to departmental specimen collection, observation of days of biological significance and organizing departmental/interdepartmental exhibitions, workshops, field trips and educational excursions for students. - 1) Ragging is a punishable crime under law and If ragging is found in any form or intimidation of any sort, he/she will be expelled forthwith and the law of the land will take its own course of action
- 2) Dress Code: All students are expected to follow the dress code of the College.
- 3) The college campus is a smoke/drug free zone.
- 4) All terms and conditions set forth, including fees and dues are liable to be revised whenever necessary.
- 5) As Holy Cross is marked by its family spirit the general behaviour and conduct of everyone in the campus is expected to be dignified and cordial, promoting comradeship and harmony.
- 6) Use of mobile is not permitted within the classrooms, labs & library, Unless it is required for the class
- 7) As Holy Cross is an English medium College, all are expected to communicate only in English while in the Campus.
- 8) As the college is currently offering only regular courses and not correspondence courses, attendance to classes is compulsory
- 9) Online Anti-Ragging affidavit to be submitted by the student & guardian as per UGC, regulations on Ragging.

Attendance

Attendance is compulsory. A student absenting himself/herself from one or more classes will lose the day's attendance. Students having less than 75% attendance are liable to be debarred from examinations (Any student absent for one month without valid reason and prior permission will have his/her name removed from the college register). Readmission formalities will have to be followed then if debarred allowed to join back. Any student absent from the College for 3 or more days needs to furnish an explanation to the HoD on rejoining classes. Medical leave needs to be substantiated with medical certificates and such emergencies should be reported to the HoD /Authorities at the earliest.

Assessment of Students

The College does continuous internal assessment of the students through regular tests, projects and assignments, The average marks secured by the students at these assessments are considered before sending up the student for University examinations. The examination committee's decision in this regard is final and binding.
